WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS 2024

Moldmaking: June 14th & Aug 23rd

Instructor: Brett | SUM290 & SUM300 | Cost \$200

We are happy to have Brett from Mudshark back! This hands-on mold making workshop will allow you to bring home a working 2 piece mold.

What to bring & what is included? Please bring several objects to choose from which should be the size of an apple/mug.





Testing The Waters: Jun 28th & Aug 30th

Instructor(s): Greta & Skyler | Cost: \$40 SUM291 & SUM301

Fascinated by the magic of the potters wheel and never had a chance to try it?! Now is your chance before committing to a class! This class will lead you through the basics of centering and pulling up cylinders.

What to bring & what is included? All materials provided. You can take home whatever you make (unfired)

Traditional Raku 1: Jul 12th

Instructor: Wil | SUM292 | Cost: \$90

This hands-on workshop will feature the basics of raku using our trash can quick fire Raku kiln and our glazes developed for the raku process. You will see lots of "Flash" from the copper present in the glaze and experience the flame and excitement of raku.

What to bring & what is included?

Bring a couple bisque pieces to fire (best if fired to ^08-06). Glaze will be provided for your use! You will take home your finished pieces.



Textured Decorative Platters: Jul 12th

This class will go over several texture & construction techniques for decorative platters. It will employ several handbuilding techniques but will ultimately be finished on the wheel. All skill levels welcome.

What to bring & what is included? Bring your basic throwing tools. You can take home whatever you make (unfired).

Raku 2 (Exploring New Techniques): Jul 19th

Instructor: Wil | SUM294 | Cost \$90

This hands-on workshop will explore several of the hot new techniques in the raku world -- "Naked" Raku and "Horsehair" Raku. Wil will have slip made up for the Naked Raku, and will share his recipe with you as well.

What to bring & what is included? Bring a couple bisque pieces to fire (best if fired to ^08-06) Glaze will be provided for your use. You will take home your finished pieces!





Sgraffito & Mishima Decoration: Jul 19th

Instructor: Aaron | SUM304 | Cost \$90



Come learn how to decorate with two clay carving techniques. Sgraffito is an Italian work meaning to carve into a colored clay surface revealing a different color underneath. Mishima is a Japanese term for a Korean style of carving into wet clay and inlaying color into the carved lines and grooves.

What to bring & what is included?

Two greenware coasters (^6) included to carve and decorate to take home (unfired). *Georgie's will provide carving tools to use, but you may bring your own too.

Marbling Clay: Jul 26th

Instructor: Nick | SUM295 | Cost \$75



This class is an introduction to the world of marbling clay. Nick will start the class with a discussion about coloring clay bodies, interactions, wedging, throwing, trimming, and more. In the second part of the class, you will make a piece out of preset marbled clay on the wheel. This class requires some experience with wheel throwing.

What to bring & what is included? Bring your basic throwing tools. You can take home whatever you make (unfired)

Tripod Vase: Aug 2nd

Instructor: Stephanie | SUM296 | Cost \$60

This Hand-Building project is loaded with tons of techniques. We will create a vessel, add three feet then incorporate some altering. Stephanie will demonstrate this project step-by-step and then set you free to put your own creative spin on your tripod vase. This class will be for beginners as well as seasoned clay artists.

Seed Pod Rattles: Aug 9th

Explore making a seed pod out of two simple pinch pots. And let's make it even more exciting and turn it into a rattle! Stephanie has taught this project to 100's of students! And every time she watches the classroom turn into a creative frenzy. If you've been wanting to dabble in the world of sculpture, this is a great opportunity to gain some clay skills and have lots of fun in the process. This class is for beginners as well as seasoned artists.
