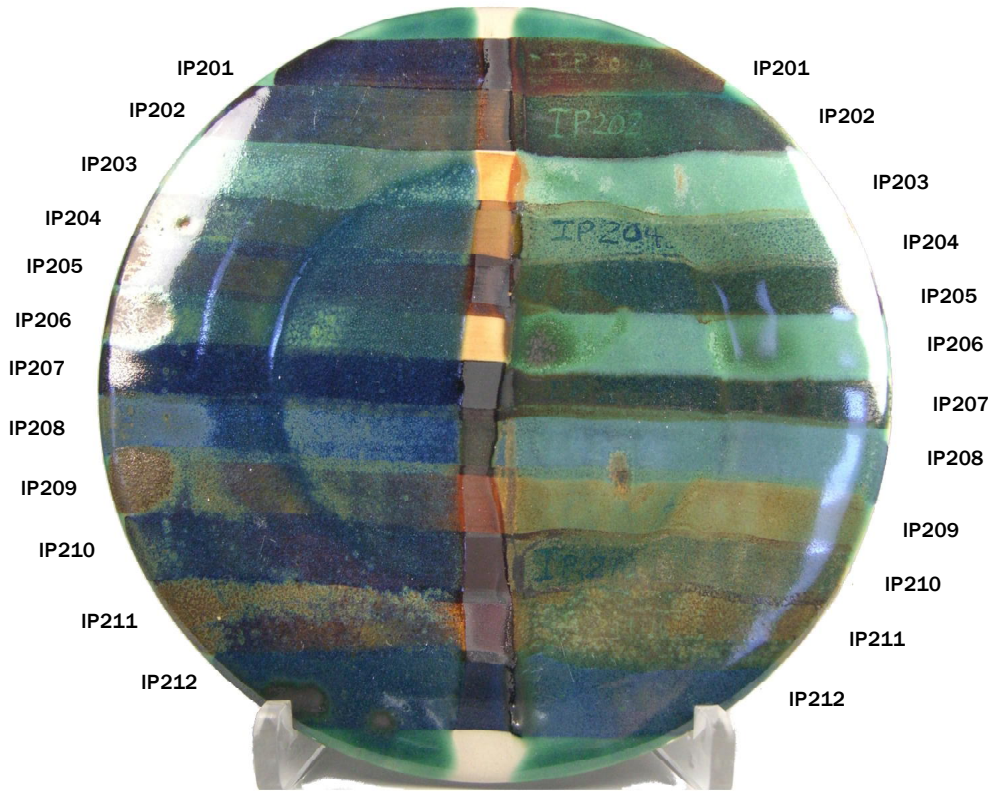


# IP200 Pigments vs PG634 Scotch Pine

(on Georgies' G-Mix Δ6 clay)

**Under the Glaze**      **Bare Pigment**      **Over the Glaze**



This side shows the IP200 pigments applied UNDER PG634 Scotch Pine.

This side shows the IP200 pigments applied OVER PG634 Scotch Pine.

- IP201 ..... Maroon with mottled floating blue
- IP202 ..... Bluish brown
- IP203 ..... Mottles yellow to mint green with purple-y blues
- IP204 ..... Mottles blue with deep purple
- IP205 ..... Breaking deep purple & blue
- IP206 ..... Mottling/breaking purple, blue & green
- IP207 ..... Bright blue & purple
- IP208 ..... Bright medium-to-dark blue mottle
- IP209 ..... Mottled blue & purple with some golden brown
- IP210 ..... Deep purple & blue mottle
- IP211 ..... Golden brown spots float in purple/mauve
- IP212 ..... Breaking blue

- Breaking red-brown ..... IP201
- Breaking mottle of soft mint green ..... IP202
- Breaking blue under golden green ..... IP203
- ..... IP204
- Breaking brown & blue ..... IP205
- Soft mint green ..... IP206
- Breaking brown & blue ..... IP207
- Light heathered, warm medium blues .... IP208
- Breaking golden tan with green & blue ..... IP209
- Golden brown mottle over blue ..... IP210
- Golden brown mottle over green ..... IP211
- Breaking medium-to-dark blue ..... IP212
