**SUM320 Garden Class 1: Planters and Garden Gnomes**  
Summer is here!! Now is your chance to add a little UMPH to your yard. Make a planter and garden gnome to accentuate what mother nature brings – with color and excitement.

*All materials provided. Firing included \*Georgies will clear glaze your pieces*



**SUM321 Garden Class 2: Garden Zen Lanterns**

Add a little fun and bring a little zen to your yard by building yard lanterns – lighting them up with LEDS or just to let the sun play through – the perfect addition to your space!

**SUM322 Raku 1: Traditional Raku**

This hands-on workshop will feature the basics of raku using our trash can quick fire Raku kiln and our glazes developed for the raku process. You will see lots of “Flash” from the copper present in the glaze and experience the flame and excitement of raku.

*Bring a couple of bisque pieces to fire (best if fired to ~08-06). Roughly the size of small bowl/mug. Glaze will be provided.*



**SUM323 Learn How To Successfully Sgraffito!**

Learn practical tips and tricks for successful sgraffito using pre-drawn designs, underglaze, and carving tools. In this class, you’ll create two tiles featuring provided images while exploring this unique surface decoration technique on greenware.

*All material is provided. We will glaze fire two tiles for you.*



**SUM324 Home Class 1: Cooking in Clay Vessels**

There is a long tradition, cultural and social, of cooking in clay vessels. This class will explore those made from terra cotta using our Cascadia Red clay. These pieces will not need to be glazed to function and make great food! Students will have the ability to make two different baking dish option that’s provided.

*All material is provided. Your pieces will be fired and ready to use.*



**SUM325 Raku 2: Exploring New Techniques (Horsehair Raku)**

This hands-on workshop will explore several of the hot new techniques in the raku world – “Naked” Raku and “Horsehair” Raku. Instructor will have slip made up for the Naked Raku.

*Bring a couple of bisque pieces to fire (best if fired to ~08-06). Glaze will be provided.*



**SUM326 Frozen Pond & Peacock Glazing**

Get hands-on with the popular Peacock and Frozen Pond glazing techniques in this engaging workshop! You’ll work with two bisque-fired, ready-to-glaze bowls and a curated selection of glazes. As you experiment, you’ll see how each method creates unique results—even when using the exact same glaze combinations.

**SUM327 Testing the Waters: Wheel 101**

Fascinated by the magic of the potter’s wheel and never had chance to try it? Now is your chance to try the wheel before committing to a class.

**SUM328 Underglaze Surface Decorating**

Looking to increase your ability to use underglaze surface decoration? This class will go through three different methods including: bubble underglaze painting, shaving cream underglaze marbling, and how to use underglaze transfers correctly. Now is the time to play around and learn how to add value to your pieces!

**SUM329 Home Class 2: Table Accessories for your next bash!**

Time to make your own custom table accessories for your next bash! Salt and Pepper shakers, Cream and Sugar, Oil and Vinegar, Corn cob butterers and toast racks are project options for this class!
