There are only 3 ways to cut these tiles: Laser (CO2 laser)

Water jet cutter

Very high quality diamond drill

There was one other tip that Robin passed along. Since these tiles are vitreous you want to work on a warming tray. Robin suggested a garage sale or kitchen supply.

Warming the piece as you work allows the water to burn off and create a good adhesion of your decorating material to the substrate.

There was one other New Product that was introduced , but we ran out of time to have it demo'd, and that is a product called **KERAFLEX**. Keraflex is a ^10 porcelain paper. It is sold in sheets and may be folded, cut , sculpted, ruffled, added on to a work in progress. You wet it in water for 10-20 seconds and it becomes flexible. There is an accompanying product , 'KERAFLEX SLURRY' to be used for attachments , and presumably as a slip. When it's dry it will be very fragile. It is recommended to single fire to ^10. This product also will be translucent. At the moment this product is only available direct info@keraflex.us.
