All Duncan crystal glazes are nontoxic and lead-free. However, they should not be used inside food or drink containers because of their fired surface characteristics and possible crazing. Only CR905, CR906, CR909 and CR910 should be considered foodsafe.

** The contrasting colors in Crystal Glazes come from color pigment chips in the glaze, settle to the bottom of the jar. Stirring thoroughly is a MUST. pour the glaze into a separate dish or bowl if it will help you stir it up well. If you wish, you can pick out the largest chips and apply them to the surface of the wet glaze, by hand, where you want them. Handle pieces with crystal glazes carefully before firing: the color chips can be brushed off easily.*
