

# Summer Class Schedule

## ✧ **Beginning Pottery (Wheel)**

Have fun with clay as you explore the basic skills of making pottery on the potter's wheel in our new, expanded 8-week format. Georgies small, personal classes offer each student their own electric wheel during every class session. The right equipment, plus the fun friendly atmosphere and lots of individual attention, will have you making mugs, bowls, and cylinder vase forms in no time. This repeatable class also covers basic glazing skills, which include dipping and brushing with cone 6 electric glazes. Why not bring a friend?



## ✧ **Intermediate Pottery (Wheel)**

The clay experience is more fun the more you explore. Intermediate Pottery will continue the journey, expanding on the basic forms you learned in Beginning Pottery. The incorporation of handbuilding techniques into the intermediate class will add new elements to round forms. Lidded forms are the emphasis in this continuing, repeatable class. You will also have an opportunity to explore combinations of wheelthrown elements that utilize handmade additions: mugs with feet, lidded jars with hand-built lids, unique handles, and surface treatments. The intermediate class will add new dimensions through pattern and design, glaze techniques, oxide washes, and engobes.



## ✧ **Black-&-White Majolica**

We had so much fun with our workshop during Made With Clay Week that we wanted to explore this fun technique more fully! Class will work on both white and black backgrounds with traditional and explorative majolica techniques. Majolica is rooted in history with many cultures expressing their decorative motifs on stable white glaze. Be a part of history as you have fun with it. Class fee includes bisque tiles, bisque plates, glaze, decorative colors and firing.

## ✧ **Create A Tabletop Fountain**

Imagine your own enjoyment as you look at and listen to a fountain of your own creation. You will create all the elements and even "plumb" it together. Class includes clay, glaze, firing and one fountain pump.

## ✧ **Create A Tile Backsplash**

This special-focus tile class will use tile as a design element. Each student will have two square feet of tile to work with. You can make a dramatic mural, a tabletop or wall art, you'll create individual accents that will punctuate any room. This four-week class will keep you going: come with ideas and be prepared to work! Class fee includes two square feet of bisque tile, design colors, glaze and firing.

## ✧ **Create Your Own House Numbers**

House numbers are an invitation to your home: create your own personal invitation! The only requirements are legibility and inspiration.

### Firing Your Electric Kiln

Proper firing is the key to ceramic success. In this class, learn to operate and maintain your electric kiln for optimum results. The focus of the class is clay-related: bring your notepads and questions!

### ✧ Garden Art

So your plants are in the ground... and you need focal points? This class will help you create a birdbath and fun garden lights. Colorful or subtle, you're sure to have fun planting new ideas! Class includes clay, glaze and firing.

### ✧ Handbuilt Tableware

You'll have just enough time to explore the basics of a place setting as you learn to form clay with coils, slabs and extrusions. Class fee includes all clay, all glaze and all firing. Four weekly class sessions.

### Raku for Beginners

Where there's smoke, there's... fire! Feel the power by signing up for this hands-on one-day class where you'll learn the process from start to finish. Class covers glazing, firing, and safety info. All supplies included in fee. Class minimum is six students. Registrations may be rolled over to the next scheduled date when signups are below minimum. Please plan to bring three pieces bisque-fired to cone 08. (Bisque "test" pieces can be supplied if you're unable to bring your own.)

### ✧ Template Teapots

Wow! We could hardly fit all of you into the demo during Made With Clay Week, so we're offering this hands-on mini-class. Learn to create your own templates for repeatable construction of this fun teapot form. Create and decorate your multiples in unique ways. Class fee includes clay, glaze and firing.

### ✧ Teacher Clay Basics

This Clay Basics class will allow you more "hands-on" time as you explore clay, glaze, decoration and firing. During this four-week class you'll follow the outline for our Teacher #1 and Teacher #2 training: you'll sculpt heads, decorate tile, make birdhouses, and work on a variety of slab projects appropriate for the classroom. You'll have opportunity to load and fire your own work as well as explore glazes in more detail. This class is open to teachers, Scout leaders, and anyone just exploring clay for the first time.

# Saturday Workshops

### Cast Glass Magnets

In this class you'll learn how to create an original magnet out of clay, cast a mold with plaster and silica, then fill the mold with glass frit. You'll create two magnets. Topics covered include sculpting, basic moldmaking, properties of fusible glass, and programming Skutt kilns for firing glass. Magnets, glass and firing included in class fee. You'll pick up your finished work one week after the class session.

### Fused Glass: Jewelry

Fused glass jewelry sparkles like gems. It's as easy as layering bits of glass and melting them together. In this class you'll learn the basics of glass cutting and glass color theory. You'll come away with an understanding of glass compatibility, fusing, and annealing. This class is structured in an open and creative format. Using Uroboros glass, you'll make glass pendants, earrings and cabochons. Glass and firing is included in the class fee. Jewelry findings (parts) are not included. A list of local bead stores will be provided, where findings can be purchased. You can pick up your finished work one week after the class session.

### Fused Glass: Make a Plate

Learn the stunning effects of layering glass to create beautiful, unique glass plates. In this class you'll learn the basics of glass color theory, glass compatibility, fusing, annealing and slumping. Using Uroboros glass frit and precut 7" glass circles, you'll decorate the circles by layering glass frits. All glass and firing included in class fee. You can pick up your finished work one week after the class session.

### Moldmaking

Learn to make a two-piece plaster mold from your own original with the assistance of a master moldmaker. Fee includes supplies. You will complete a finished mold in one day. Original object must fit inside a 6x6" square box for making your mold.
