## March 16 10am -2pm Mold Making and Sprigging

Learn to make simple 1 piece molds that can be used to press relief tiles or make 'sprig' attachment for a clay form.



## March 23 10am -2pm InterActive Pigments !

Explore Georgies Interactive Pigments ! Our pigments can be used under a glaze, wiped back as a wash or Majolica style on top of a raw glaze. We will have bisque tiles in ^6 clay for you to try them. We supply 4 ,4 x 4 tile - pigment-^6 glaze and firing !



## March 30 10am -2pm Underglazes and Scraffito !

We will be using "engobe " based underglazes (Duncan Cover Coats & Amaco Velvets), which are best used on green clay allowing you to scratch or carve through the color to reveal your contrasting clay body. This produces design, contrast and color. We will have clay slabs ,tools and underglazes for you to try.



## April 6 10am -2pm Mono-Printing on Clay !

This is so much fun and many people missed this ,and asked that we repeat this fun and easy technique. It's a great drawing technique that lets you draw with underglazes on plaster and pick up the image with slip. It can be done with any firing range of clay and can be used as a flat image or cut and applied to a clay form as a clay 'tattoo'.




## April 13 10 am - 2pm Slip Casting !

Clay has many forms and the liquid version is meant to be cast into plaster molds. We'll be casting Low-Fire (04), as well as ^6 stoneware and porcelain.



## April 20 10 am - 2 pm Slip Trailing !

Slip Trailing can be easy or a practiced skill. We'll have clay slabs and slips, + a huge variety of slip trail bottles for you to try .
