

Beeswax Candles

FOR THE HOLIDAYS



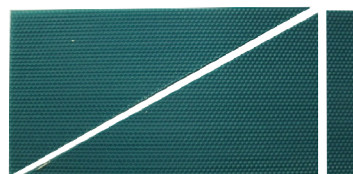
Make this charming trio
for gifts or your home decorations!

You'll Need:

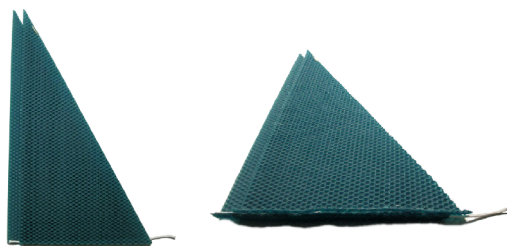
- Beeswax Sheets (8" x 16"):
 - 2 red (BX21)
 - 2 forest green (BX9)
 - 2 white (BX24)
 - Optional:* 1 sheet yellow (BX25)
 - or 1 sheet blue (BX4) or other colors of your choice.
- Flat braided wick
 - 15ft (W64A) or 60ft (W64B)
 - (Depends on how many candles you want to make)
- Scissors
- Ruler or yardstick
- X-Acto Knife, pizza cutter, utility knife, or other sharp blade
- Electric blow dryer (optional)

Make the Tree Candle

1. Beeswax sheets measure 8x16". Cut a vertical strip from the right side of the sheet, 2 to 3" wide. Keep this strip: it will come in handy later.



2. Stack the diagonal cut sheets, staggering them with about 1/2" to 1" between the pieces. Lay wick across the wide end of the bottom sheet. Pinch wick between the cut ends of the sheets.



3. Begin rolling the layers together. Don't worry if your cone shape isn't perfect. After rolling the sheets, roll the candle under your hand on a flat, firm surface to press the edges together and refine the shape. Stand the candle up on the flat, firm surface and twist lightly, too, to flatten the base.
