

## Tickled Pink Wine Cooler

### Materials Needed:

**Duncan® Oh Four® Bisque**  
21673 Wine Cooler

### Duncan® Concepts® Underglazes for Bisque

CN 233 Dark Briarwood  
CN 371 Light Honeysuckle  
CN 372 Bright Honeysuckle  
CN 373 Dark Honeysuckle

### Accessory Product

AS 548 Mask 'n Peel™  
AS 952 Brush Cleaner

### Duncan® Pure Brilliance® Clear Glaze

### Brushes

SB 803 No. 4 Liner  
SB 806 No. 6 Round  
SB 807 No. 6 Fan Glaze Brush

### Tools

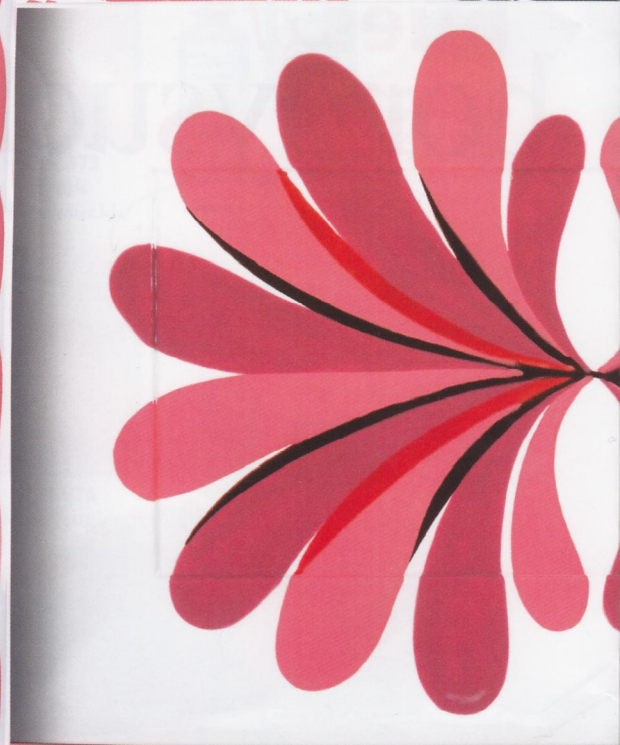
TL 420 Palette Knife

### Miscellaneous Supplies

- Potter's sponge
- Container for water
- Foil or foam plate for palette
- Soft tape measure
- Clay carbon paper
- Pencil
- Craft knife

### Instructions:

1. Wipe ware with damp sponge to remove bisque dust.
2. Use a soft tape measure to divide the wine cooler into quarters, marking lightly with pencil. Align the pattern onto one of the quarters and transfer design by placing clay carbon paper on bisque with pattern on top and tracing over design with pencil. Repeat three more times around cooler.
3. Condition the No. 4 Liner with Brush Cleaner, then apply Mask 'n Peel™ to the outside edges of the scalloped stripes and center dots in the stripes. Let dry thoroughly.
4. Using the Fan Glaze brush, apply three coats of **Light Honeysuckle** to the scalloped stripes.
5. Use Palette Knife to remove the Mask 'n Peel™.
6. Using the No. 6 Round, apply three coats of **Bright Honeysuckle** to the dots in between the scalloped stripes.
7. Using No. 6 Round, apply three coats of **Dark Honeysuckle** to rows of dots in two of the stripes, alternating stripes. Repeat with **Dark Briarwood** on the dots in remaining stripes.
8. Using Fan Glaze brush, apply three coats **Dark Honeysuckle** to the inside of cooler. Let cooler dry completely.
9. Use sponge to gently dab one coat of Duncan® Pure Brilliance® onto the entire piece. Let dry then use the Fan Glaze brush to carefully add a second coat. Let dry.
10. Stilt and fire to cone 06.

## Retro in Bloom Platter

### Materials Needed:

**Duncan® Oh Four® Bisque**  
27158 Square Collection Platter

### Duncan® Envision Glazes®

IN 1060 Bright Wine  
IN 1074 Cranberry  
IN 1082 Chocolate Brown  
IN 1083 Honeysuckle

### Duncan® Pure Brilliance® Clear Glaze

### Brushes

SB 803 No. 4 Liner  
SB 806 No. 6 Round  
SB 807 No. 6 Fan Glaze Brush

### Miscellaneous Supplies

- Potter's sponge
- Container for water
- Foil or foam plate for palette
- Clay carbon paper
- Tape measure
- Pencil

### Instructions:

1. Wipe ware with damp sponge to remove bisque dust.
2. Using tape measure, find the exact center of platter then use pencil to divide into four equal sections.
3. Align pattern with center point on tray, referring to photo. Place clay carbon paper between tray and pattern then trace over design with pencil to transfer onto the platter. Repeat for each section on platter, flipping pattern to create mirror images across dividing lines.
4. Referring to photo for placement, use No. 4 Liner to apply three coats of **Cranberry** and **Chocolate Brown** to the edges of petals as shown.
5. Using the No. 4 Liner or No. 6 Round as needed, apply three coats of **Honeysuckle** and **Bright Wine** to the petals, alternating colors.
6. Use sponge to gently dab one coat of Duncan® Pure Brilliance® onto the entire piece. Let dry then use the Fan Glaze brush to carefully add a second coat. Let dry.
7. Stilt and fire to cone 06.
