# Secrets of the Sea Shell Bowl

**Materials Needed:** Duncan® Oh Four® Bisque 29062 Large Shell Bowl

## Cover-Coat® Opaque Underglazes

CC 109 Sunset Pink CC 183 Cherry Red CC 191 Marine Blue

#### Duncan® E-Z Stroke® **Translucent Underglazes**

EZ 013 White EZ 058 Poppy Orange **EZ 101 Neon Yellow** 

### Duncan® Pure Brilliance® **Clear Glaze**

#### Brushes

SB 806 No. 6 Round SB 812 No. 10 Round

#### **Miscellaneous Supplies**

- Potter's sponge
- Container for waterFoil or foam plate for palette
- Paper towels

#### Instructions:

- Wipe ware with damp sponge to remove bisque dust.
- Rinse brush then brush a coat of Honeysuckle onto the middle section of bowl, blending into the lower portion of the **Sunset Pink** section. Brush **Cherry Red** onto the bottom section of bowl, blending up into the **Honeysuckle**. Repeat twice more.

  Following curvature on inside of bowl, use a pencil to lightly sketch an irregular floral
- Using the Fan Glaze, brush about a 1" section of **Sunset Pink** around inside of bowl just below pencil line on the outer perimeter of floral shape. Rinse brush.
- Honeysuckle upward from this section, blending into the lower part of the Sunset Pink. Repeat
- While the colors are still damp from the third coat, dip the brush into the Cherry Red and paint center
- section, brushing outward and blending into the **Honeysuckle**. Repeat twice more. Using the Fan Glaze, brush three coats of **Marine Blue** along the top inside edge of bowl,
- Use the No. 10 Round to mix a small amount of Poppy Orange into the Neon Yellow and brush into the space left between the Marine Blue and Honeysuckle. Brush loosely into
- Load the No. 6 Round into White then brush a line in the Marine Blue section near the top some of the Marine Blue background to show through. Let dry.
